Comments on the article

Effect Of Time Interval Between Collection, Plasma Separation And Analysis And The Effect Of Temperature On The Laboratory Results Of Plasma Glucose Estimation.

The manuscript has good objective, but there are some questions which have not been discussed.

The manuscript is poorly documented and has spelling mistakes

Introduction – line-4, **diabetes, prediabetes and non diabetes** should read as:  
**diabetic; prediabetic, and non diabetic,**

The word Celsius –is wrongly spelt in the entire manuscript

Figure below 2-8 0 Celsius **should be 2-8<sup>0</sup>C**

Temperatures selected have no basis

It would be better to select 2-8<sup>0</sup>C; 25<sup>0</sup>C, 30<sup>0</sup>C, 35<sup>0</sup>C, Can the authors justify the selection of their temperatures ?

If these corrections can be incorporated – the manuscript is worth publishing.
