There was no description of statistical method employed in analyzing the data and the set confidence level for acceptance of significant difference in mean yet standard deviation or standard error of mean was indicated in the numeric outcomes.</li><li>4. The seeming conclusion is merely a summary of the outcomes hence unnecessarily lengthy for a valid conclusion that should be limited to answering the research question as guided by the study aim..</li><li>5.
