EDITORIAL COMMENT’S on revised paper (if any)	Authors’ response to editor’s comments
<p>Authors have revised their manuscript accordingly. However they did not indicate if an ethical approval was obtained for the study. From the authors' guideline at the journal website, it is clearly indicated that "All manuscripts which deal with the study of human subjects must be accompanied by Institutional Review Board (IRB) or Ethical Committee Approval, or the national or regional equivalent. The name of the Board or Committee giving approval and the study number assigned must accompany the submission. If required, the author should be ready to submit a scanned copy of the IRB or Ethical Committee Approval at any stage of publication (Pre or post publication stage)." Authors should be informed of this very important ethical requirement.</p>	<p>ETHICAL APPROVAL</p> <p>This study was carried out in accordance with the Declaration of Helsinki. To respect confidentiality, the hospitalization number of the file was used for each patient. This study was a hospital-based research conducted under routine conditions.</p>
