CLASSIFICATION OF 4448 DISEASES IN SIDDHA SYSTEM OF MEDICINE – A REVIEW

ABSTRACT

Siddha Medicine is a system of Traditional Medicine originating in ancient Sri Lanka and Tamil Nadu in South India. Traditionally, it is taught the *siddhars* laid the foundation for this system of Medication. Siddhars were spiritual adepts who possessed the ashta siddhis or eight super natural powers. Agastyar is considered the first Siddhar and the guru of all siddhars. The Siddha System of Medicine is believed to have been handed over to him by Murugan, Son of Shivan and Parvathi. Siddha system considers the human body as a collection of tri-humors & seven basic elements. Vatham, Pitham & Kapham are the trihumors which are the life constituents of the human body. The equilibrium of humors is consider as health & its disturbance or imbalance leads to disease. The aim of the study is to identify the 4448 diseases according to the Siddha Literatures. 4448 diseases are mentioned in Agasthiyar 2000, Angathipatham, Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal part I and Theriyar vaakadam. Siddhar Aruvai Maruthuvam book stated that Head and Neck diseases are 1008. Diseases are classified according to anatomical structures of body parts, tri humors and diseases. Totally, 95 diseases are explained in all five books. In Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal Part II, 51 diseases and its types and In Yugi Vaiththiya Sinthamani, 27 diseases and its types are explained in the books. Totally, 544 and 431 Number of diseases are explained in the text Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal Part II and Yugi Vaiththiya Sinthamani respectively. It is quite evidence from this review that 4448 diseases are in the Siddha System of Medicine. These collected information are helpful for further studies in types of diseases.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 BACKGROUND OF STUDY

Agastyar is considered the first *Siddhar* & the guru of all *siddhars*, the Siddha system is believed to have been handed over to him by Shiva [1]. Siddha system considers the human body as a collection of tri-humors & seven basic elements. *Vatham*, *Pitham* & *Kapham* are the tri-humors which are the life constituents of the human body. The equilibrium of humors is consider as health & its disturbance or imbalance leads to disease [2].

Expecting the diseases caused by our previous births, the diseases caused by our present birth are due to our food habits. This has been rightly quoted in the following verse by Saint *Thiruvalluvar:*

The food and actions of a person should be in association with the nature of his body. Any increase or decrease in a humor *Vali*, *Azhal*, *Aiyam* leads to the derangement of the three humors. The agreement of actions means his good words, deeds and actios. According to *Thiruvalluvar* the disease is caused due to the increase or decrease in the equllibrium of three humors.

The common causes for a person to be affliated with diseases are mentioned in the following verse of *Theriyar* in his *Karisal*:

It is a review of classification of 4448 diseases in relevant literatures

3.2Study setting

Data for the literature review were collected from related literatures and websites.

In *Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal* Part II, 51 diseases and its types and In *Yugi Vaiththiya Sinthamani*, 27 diseases and its types are explained in the books. Totally, 544 and 431 Number of diseases are explained in the text *Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal* Part II and *Yugi Vaiththiya Sinthamani* respectively.

5.RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Agasthiyar 2000, Angathipatham, Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal part I and Theriyar vaakadam books have been stated that types of diseases are 4448. In Agasthiyar 2000, 4448 diseases further classified into 3. There are Vatha Diseases: 1482; It is caused by disturbance of Vatha Thosam, Pitha Diseases: 1483; It is caused by disturbance of Pitha Thosam. These diseases increase the body heat and inflammation and Kapha Diseases: 1483; It is caused by disturbance of Kapha Thosam.

Diseases are classified according to anatomical structures of body parts, tri humors and diseases. According to the tri humors, *Vatha* diseases and *Pitha* diseases are mentioned in *Agasthiyar 2000* and *Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal part II*. Number of *vatha* diseases are approximately same (B1:84, B3:85). But in *Yugi Muni vaithiya sinthaman*i book is mentioned that *vatha* diseases are 80 in number so number of *vatha* disease is 80 -85. Number of *pitha* diseases are not same in number (B1:83, B3:42). But in *Yugi Muni vaithiya sinthaman*i and *Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal part I* books are mentioned that *pitha* diseases are 42 in number so number of *vatha* disease may be 42. *Kapha* diseases are mentioned in *Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal part I* and *Theriyar vaakadam*. Number of *Kapha* diseases are approximately same (96:100). But in *Yugi Muni vaithiya sinthaman*i book is mentioned that *Kapha* diseases are 21 in number so number of *kapha* diseases are unable to state in actual number.

Diseases are classified according to the anatomical structures of body parts such as head, ear, mouth, eye, neck, nose, cheek, forehead, occipital region of the head (*Pidari*), upper limbs, abdomen, male genitalia, abdomen, scrotum, lower limbs, thigh region, lumbo sacral region, navel, rib cage, *thanaththil*, arm, chest, anal region, calf muscles and knee joint, heart, foot, joints, shoulder, bones, nerves, eye brow and groin region.

Diseases in ear, Diseases in eye and Diseases in nose are explained in number value in all 5 books. Number of diseases in eye are approximately same (B1, B2, B3, B5:96, B4:95). So, Number of eye disease is 96. Number of nose diseases (27) are same in *Agasthiyar 2000* and *Angathipatham*. Diseases in neck are explained in number value in 4 books. Diseases in head, Diseases in mouth, Diseases in neck, Diseases in cheek, Diseases in occipital region of head (*Pidari*), Diseases in thigh, Diseases in lumbo sacral region and Diseases in navel are explained in number value

in 3 books. Number of diseases in cheek are approximately same (B1:40, B2:32, B5:49). Number of diseases in occipital region of head are equal in 2 books (B1:10 & B2:10). Diseases in fore head, Diseases in upper limb, Diseases in *abanan*, Diseases in back, Diseases in chest and Diseases in anal region are explained in number value in 2 books. Number of diseases in fore head are approximately same (B1:32, B5:26). Number of diseases in upper limbs are equal (B1: 130 & B2: 130). Number of diseases in anal region are approximately same (B2: 101 & B4: 100).

Totally, 95 diseases are explained in all five books. In *Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal* Part II, 51 diseases and its types and In *Yugi Vaiththiya Sinthamani*, 27 diseases and its types are explained in the books. Totally, 544 and 431 Number of diseases are explained in the text *Noi Naadal Noi Muthal Naadal* Part II and *Yugi Vaiththiya Sinthamani* respectively.

6. CONCLUSION

It is quite evidence from this review that 4448 diseases are in the Siddha System of Medicine. These collected information are helpful for further studies in types of diseases.
