Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The reason for choosing this school is because it is part of a healthy village tourism study, in this item the school's justification must be supported or expanded, since the study is about knowledge and habits related to solid waste management , it would be pertinent to know what conditions the school has that make this one chosen and not another.</p> <p>The reason for choosing the level of education of the respondents: the age of the children doing the study is not taken into account. It is important to relate their cognitive maturity with attitudes and perception of the environment that surrounds them.</p> <p>It is important to establish the type of information provided to children, what were the topics covered, types of waste, separation, organic and inorganic waste?</p> <p>It is important to know if the children in their school education have a subject that deals with issues related to solid waste management as part of the curricular content.</p> <p>It is a perception study, it is necessary to know the school context in its social dynamics in order to understand the answers given. For example: if the answers given by children is that there are no toilets in the bathrooms, it may be because there really are no due to the economic conditions of the school, it is the custom of the area that they are not there or simply because the children do not know or do not remember that there is.</p> <p>Table 3 and 4 show practically the same information, everything could be consolidated into a single table.</p> <p>The information shown says that punishments are applied due to inadequate waste management. Was it explored what kind of actions are given to children that they consider punishments?</p> <p>The conclusion should be improved with specific data resulting from the work done, it should also point out that improvement aspects should be taken into account specifically to be implemented at the level of the curricula.</p>
