	This retrospective cohort study on which the author describes the evolution of the new pandemic COVID-19 in the Assiut province, located at the middle of Upper Egypt on the River Nile, This retrospective cohort study includes all reported COVID-19 cases during the period from the 7 th of March to the 17 th September 2020 (end of the 1 st wave). The author's findings corroborate data from the literature indicating a greater susceptibility of elderly (male) patients. However, it is necessary to correlate in more detail the factors of aggravating health (co-morbity), mainly diabetes, hypertension and obesity associating them to pour prognosis. In addition, the author should describe in the article which factors contributed to the sharp drop in the number of cases in July, August and September. The graphic figures lack statistical analysis.	
Optional/General comments	In general the manuscript is well built but in some situations it is necessary to improve English. A revision of the entire manuscript is necessary in order to eliminate possible and subtle linguistic distortions .
