<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	The authors present interesting data about medicinal plants reduces the rapid progression of infection in the community based on the simulation seen at Fig. 1 and Fig. 2. The authors formulate mathematical model that include medicinal plant class to observe whether medicinal plants give an effect or not to the number of infectious. The authors report that there is a decreasing in the number of susceptible infected infant population which is possibly due to the high rate of medicinal plants and the number of recovered infants increase when using these medicinal plants. Determinant factors for infectious disease are also evaluated. The manuscript is well written, has important clinical message, and should be of great interest to the readers. However, there are a couple of minor issues that have been mentioned in the "minor revision comments". Overall, it is an important study, and should be considered for publication in JMSRR once the minor issues have been resolved.	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	There are still a couple of (relatively minor) changes which would be advisable: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Please re-check and re-write in-text citation properly.</li> <li>2. p3 line 26 just write the number either in word or in number, no need to put both.</li> <li>3. Table 2- adjust the width for the table and make sure that every item can clearly be seen.</li> <li>4. Table 3 row1, column 2- I think the authors duplicate the item where it supposed to write "type of disease" may be?</li> </ol>
