A lot of references were listed, namely 84, but references from 54 to 84 are not mentioned in the text. They are only present in Table 1. Usually in the review articles at least some comments / comparisons / descriptions are written the text about all references. This should be done. Further on, Figures 2, 3 and 4 are also not described in the text, which must be corrected.  In my opinion, the core of the manuscript should be rewritten according to the comments. I added my other minor comments in the word.doc. The conclusion part is o.k. only minor revisions such as italic for "in vitro" are needed.	
Minor REVISION comments	Through all manuscript "in vitro" and "in vivo" should be italic. And there are some typing mistakes.
