

**Editor's Comment:**

The study concludes that the conflict situation in the communities has been reduced due to CBOs intervention by promoting social change in favour of the poor, marginalized, and deprived. The CBOs also recognized the potential of the caste and religious group's differences in causing conflicts among the people in the communities, and accordingly strive to mediate in terms of peace building processes. The study correctly employed the survey research design using focus group discussions and key informant interviews to collect the empirical evidence, analyzed the data and drawn evidence based conclusion. It is a well documented paper with available references put in place.
