I am confused by the Authors' answer concerning the activity of SOD. I asked about the superscripts which in Table 2 are indicative for no statistical significant difference of SOD values in subgroup with 70% ethanol only compared to G. kola pretreatment + 70% ethanol. However, the Authors surprisingly have changed "reduced" for "increased" in the text of the manuscript leaving the superscripts in Table 2 as they were before ???? So, are the SOD values significantly different or not ? There was the statement: "Values with different superscript along the same row are significantly different at $P < 0.05$.", but SOD values are marked as ^b and ^b for the aforementioned groups. Please, explain this issue.

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
