

Editor's Comment:

I have now examined the manuscript "From Fossil Fuels to Renewable Biogas Production from Biomass Based Feedstock – A Review of Anaerobic Digester Systems and received reviewers' comments from you.

In view of the comments and recommendations made, I have decided that the manuscript is considered for publication. However, it still needs to be revised in order to meet the standard of JENRR.

For the author's guidance, I append the comment below.

The the article is too long (42 pages) (reviewer 1 have commented on this issue, but the authors have not been reduced it yet). Generally, the maximum length of the review paper category is 20 pages (maximum 10,000 words). So please reduce the page length of the article into 20 pages. Authors need to be able to distinguish writing articles for journals very different from writing books or theses.

There are a few suggestions to the authors to revise their article:

- sub-chapters 1.1-1.6 are summarized into one paragraph, then placed it in section 1 as paragraph 2.
- In the final paragraph, please add a strategic way to deal with the problem, namely by developing renewable energy. One of them is the development of biogas. Please explain briefly why biogas?
- Prolog section 2, 2.1 and 2.3 are summarized into one subsection, namely (2.1).
- Sections 4.3 and 4.4 and 4.5 are summarized and combined into one sub-section. Figures 8, 9, and 10 are placed in one place next

to each other and given the notation 8a, b, and c (the size of the image is minimized which is clearly important).

- Likewise, sections 4.12 and 4.13 (becoming one subsection), sections 4.14 and 4.15.
- All sizes of the image should be minimized which is clearly important.
