2. ...patient may be screened...
3. ...white paper... is it white paper or review article?
4. ...CRF problem including...
5. The sentence...This white paper.....current evidence. Sentence is vague
6. Similarly the sentence "...option for treatment.....addiction liability" is vague sentence.

Thus, it indicates that there could be chances of several grammatical errors in the manuscript.
