If this is a systematic review, the result has not been achieved. What are the statistical methods used? The manuscript must be made simpler and more comprehensive and must meet the criteria of a systematic review.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In the material and method section, the inclusion and exclusion criteria of the studies included in our study are more clearly stated.2. The databases used in our study are explained.3. This study is not a systematic analysis, but consists of comparing non-invasive serum MM diagnostic tests with AS rates obtained in studies using invasive FNB and CNB methods in the diagnosis of TCs.4. The statistical methods used in our study are explained in the material and method section and marked in blue.
