EDITORIAL COMMENT'S on revised paper (if any)	Authors' response to editor's comments
<p>I have found many mistakes and unusual fragments into the text. Below, I have described some points that needs a strong revision by the authors:</p> <p>#1: They need to clarify the aim of this study.</p> <p>#2: what is "key wards"? I have never seen it before in a scientific manuscript.</p> <p>#3: They must avoid abbreviations. They must write the full name of the expressions into the text.</p> <p>#4. What was the main hypothesis tested in this study? I cannot find any sentence into the text presenting it.</p> <p>#5. What was the used reference to determine nutrient levels?</p> <p>#6. The description of statistical analysis is lacking. Also, they need to rewrite the whole material and methods sections. It is not an unusual way to describe methods. The current section is totally inappropriate.</p> <p>#7. Without a statistical analysis description into the material and methods section is hard to review their results section.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It has mentioned clearly, the purpose of the study related with, in ABSTRACT. 2. Yes, it has been removed from the ABSTRACT. 3. Yes, every abbreviations have been removed and written full name of expressions into text. 4. Yes, it has mentioned now in materials and methods.(The bread wheat cv. PBW-343 variety was used for its performance in the experimental research as a test crop through integrated nutrient mangement during <i>rabi</i> season 2018-19 and 2019-20 and effect on chemcio-biological properties of soil) 5. Yes, mistake have been corrected. Actually it should be nitrogen levels in place of nutrient levels.
