So long, but did not discuss what is FC, SC, ST &amp; BC.</li> <li><b>2. Results &amp; Discussion-</b> the current article is limited to social justice, fairness and empowerment but these are not discussed. Descriptions of Conflict should have subheadings as: existence of caste system, differences in religion and development opportunities. Tables and figures must be about these three only. One for each.</li> <li><b>3. References: Rawls 1971, Freire not in the references</b></li> </ol>	<p>The introduction includes the review of literature as a background to the study and the statement of the problem. The last paragraph in the introduction also specifies the objectives that the study seek to achieve. With all these in mind, the length of the introduction seems plausible for the manuscript.</p> <p>The result is discussed based on the research instrument that was designed to achieve the objectives of the study and does not necessarily have to be limited to three tables, limiting a full understanding of the problem and the locus of the research material.</p> <p>The name <b>Fiere</b> refers to the educator from whom "empowerment" as a theory originated from.
