Abstract must be arranged following the format: aim-methodology-findings-conclusion.- Yes, it is arranged but still no conclusion, and not revised in terms of better sentence construction & logical organization of ideas (English conventions in writing) I have included my revision for the abstract see manuscript</p> <p>3. Introduction- provide literature about Surajpur district- e.g. geography, economy, agriculture; and suicide (cause and effect)- Still no discussion about Surajpur, even in the methodology</p> <p>4. First section of the questionnaire under Materials and method not discussed in the Results. Use Methodology, instead of materials and method</p> <p>5. Results on symptoms- not included in the questionnaire (materials & method)- instead of Symptoms, use Experiences prior to suicide</p> <p>6. Results on social causes, farm-related causes - discuss only the top 3 results – Farming related, indebtedness, and impact has no discussion</p> <p>7. Table 3 – why the total is not 100%? You have presented more than 100%. You failed to explain this.</p> <p>8. Table 3 (neighbours/friends/relatives- what is the significance of this in the study? You mentioned in methodology that primary data were collected from neighbors/friends/relatives but you failed to mention what are those questions, only victim households were asked of answer questions so why n/f/r are included in the table?</p> <p>9. Table 6- how many respondents do you have? Is it the same number with previous tables? 50 in total, how many are victim households? Neighbors/friends/relatives? Not stated in methodology?</p> <p>10. AYY in social causes must be discussed. What is this? What does it mean?</p> <p>11.
