Compulsory REVISION comments	The manuscript describes the skin fungal infections in cows caused by non-dermatophytes. Sample number is impressive and results are valuable and well discussed. I have some major comments for the authors. Firstly, the language needs to be improved. There are a lot of misspellings and grammar errors. For me the problem is also data presentation. Tables describing isolated species and their frequencies are fine, but I do not understand the gel photograph – what are those blue lines pointing at some of the bands? Also it is good to check pathogenicity of isolated fungi, but for me the lack of the diagram or table summarizing these results is unfortunate.
