However, the author should consider:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Author to include more theoretical underpinnings – for example WEB Du Bois to strengthen their argument • Minimal information (and no mention) of police brutality which is also one of the core social issues that BLM are tackling • Certain statements require more comparative analysis between the two movements – see comments on paper • Another proof-read as there are spelling and grammatical errors. Some paragraphs also do not make logical sense. • The author does not reference where they have found their information. See paper where I have identified to reference. <p>Author to provide references of where they found most of their information.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>Some of the wording or concepts used may be consider politically incorrect (considering the nature of the paper). Author can consider the revision of this – see paper where I have identified.</p>
