Optional/General comments	The manuscript is interesting for the researchers and growers of Shallot plants, especially those working on mulching and organic manure. The current study is evaluating the response of Shallot plants (growth and yield) to different mulching types and chicken manures doses. Authors have given sufficient data on different growth parameters and yield production. Authors have concluded that the black plastic mulch was the best treatment for fresh tuber weight per hectare (11.74 ton/ha). Chicken manure at dose of 20 ton/ha positively affected the plant height, number of leaves, fresh tuber weight per hectare and dry weight per hectare. There was no effect of the interaction between mulch types and chicken manure doses on growth and yield of shallot. The paper is clear and the language is fine. The manuscript can be accepted for publication in Asian Plant Research Journal after minor revision (Pleas, use the attached file for more corrections).
