<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	Inclusion and exclusion criteria are missing. ESR is not a measure of inflammation. Rationale is not clear. The authors need to state- what type of ART was used. The authors did not assess for any ageing markers. The authors are suggested to assess the signature proinflammatory markers- IL1 $\beta$ , IFN $\gamma$ for determining inflammation. What is the rationale for doing correlational study between ESR and CRP. The authors are suggested to show the expression level of each marker (CRP, ESR) among different groups in a single graph. The groups needs to be renamed.	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	Language correction is essential.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	The authors focus on to demonstrate "inflammaging," however, does not assess any ageing markers. Further naming of the groups are confusing and data presentation needs to be improved as mentioned in the major comments.
