<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. You used animal model thus you have to declare an official animal research ethics approval.</li> <li>2. The sample size (5 rats/group) is too small for quantitative analyses.</li> <li>3. You measured liver enzymes from the liver extract. This is not the way to analyze hepatotoxicity. These enzymes are normally in hepatocytes so the amount/activity of them in liver extract do not indicate liver damage. To determine the hepatotoxicity, you must measure these enzymes leaked from injury hepatocytes in blood.</li> </ol>
