The author does not need to add the following sentence in the methodology "inferential statistics test (repeated measurement of mixed method and post hoc test, least significant difference of LSD) were analyzed. SPSS 23 software was used to analyze the data"</li> </ol> <p><b>Introduction</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. The author should be very synthetic in the introduction, just write the essentials. There is a lot of repetitions and explications which make the introduction too long and less interesting.</li> </ol> <p><b>Methodology</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Write the methodology in sub-paragraphs with subtitles. Those paragraphs and subtitles should include a paragraph on patient's selection, Acupressure Therapy, experimental design, data collection and statistical analysis</li> <li>5. In the paragraph of statistical analysis, be specific because inferential statistics test is the set of statistical tests including parametric and non-parametric tests.</li> <li>6. Results</li> <li>7. In this part of the manuscript, the clarity of presentation is very poor</li> <li>8. The interpretation of the results is mixed with methodology. Some interpretations are not suitable for the results in the tables (Table1&amp;2).</li> <li>9. Figure 1 should be well treated and interpreted. As it is presented, it's just a draft.</li> </ol> <p><b>Discussion</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>10. It will be considered after well presentation and interpretation of the results.</li> </ol> <p><b>Reference list</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>11. It must be correct immensely, there is a lot of error.</li> </ol>
