I would recommend to make some tables answering the following questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) What skin infections were the patients examined for? 2) Is there any connection between the isolated gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria and localization and form of skin infection? 3) How were the gram-positive and gram-negative bacterial isolates distributed among the hospital departments? 	
Optional/General comments	<p>It would also be advisable to correct the typos in the text and to add to the references the literature of the last five years.</p>
